

Auckland Regional Exit Breath Survey 2005

The Auckland Regional Alcohol Project (RAP) group invites you to the launch of the Auckland Regional Exit Breath Survey 2005.

The survey has been conducted by SHORE and Te Ropu Whariki at Massey University. It measures breath test readings as well as interviewer assessment and self-reported intoxication levels of over 300 young people exiting from randomly selected bars throughout the region. Participants also completed a short interview covering their transport, drinking and eating activities that evening. The launch will provide an overview of survey results both regionally and by local authority area.
